- Kendall Jelinovic of Lettire Construction came to seek a letter of support to the Department of Buildings for Lettire Construction to extend work hours on Saturday from 8AM – 5PM. Lettire Construction is building 120 units of affordable housing at 960 Prospect Avenue, for which, Thesalonia Baptist Church is a community partner. They hope to complete construction by October of 2018. The apartments are part of HPD and will be subject to all of their rules and regulations.
