- Jeff Kohn of Nicholas Lence Communications and Leonel Cortizo of Clean Energy presented on Clean Energy fuels new CNG fueling station in Hunts Point on Ryawa Avenue. The station will have 2 pumps and 4 hoses and is projected to open in Spring 2018. The station will have security cameras, but will be manned by the operators. Companies will open an account with Clean Energy and be given card access to the site. Current companies include Manhattan Beer and Baldor's.
- JS Food Pantry presented because they are looking for a space within the CB2 community for a food pantry & a weekly soup kitchen. They currently operate mainly in Morris Park, but do pop-ups throughout the community including at Erma Cava's & Community Access. They would like a permanent location that would open once a week as a soup kitchen, but will be open the other days as a pantry. They would like a space with a kitchen on-site and seating for 50-60 people.
